- Top Left:** Kitchen (キッチン) and Office (じむしつ).
- Top Center:** Meeting Room (かいぎしつ) and Activity Room (さーくろしつ).
- Top Right:** Workshop Room1 and Workshop Room2.
- Middle Left:** Stairs (かいだん) and a Lounge area with a table and chairs.
- Middle Center:** Dining & Shopping area with a counter and stools.
- Middle Right:** Eating Area and an Information Desk (①Information Desk).
- Bottom Left:** Auditorium and Stage.
- Bottom Center:** A large open area with a grid of trees.
- Bottom Right:** Bicycle Parking and a Traffic Rule Information sign.

Key features and signs include:

- Entrance:** Marked with a blue arrow pointing to the Dining & Shopping area.
- WC:** Multiple restrooms are located throughout the plan.
- EV:** Electric Vehicle charging station.
- Floor Guide:** A green sign indicating the layout.
- No Entry Allowed:** A grey sign with a red 'X' over a door.
- Bicycle Parking:** A designated area for bicycles.
