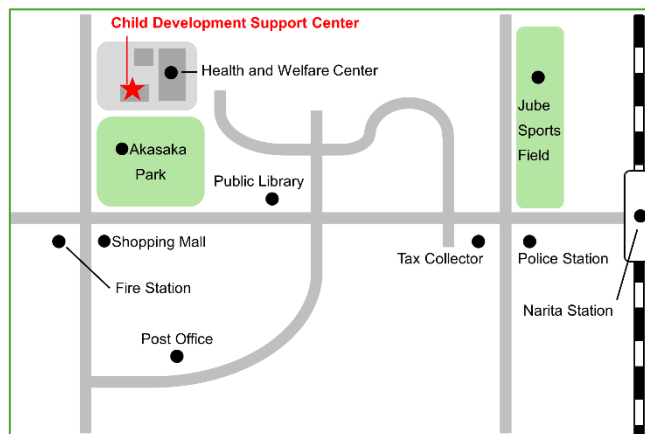


Please feel free to call us first.

Child Development Support Center

This is a facility where children with developmental disorders, developmental differences, or physical disabilities, and their guardians can attend together for support.

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Child Development Support

To help children develop the skills needed for daily life and learn how to adapt to their surroundings, we provide support through therapy while the child attends together with a parent or guardian.



Eligible users:

Children aged 0 to pre-school age who live in Narita City

● Small-Group Therapy (approximately 5 children per group)

We support development through group activities and play.

○ Water Therapy / Music Therapy

For children using small-group therapy, we invite specialized instructors to provide special therapeutic programs.

Music Therapy

● Individual Therapy

Specialized staff provide guidance tailored to each child's needs and offer advice on activities that can be done at home.

○ Speech Therapy

Eligible users:

Children with delayed language development, pronunciation errors, stuttering, or hearing-related difficulties.



Speech Consultation Room

○ Occupational Therapy

Eligible users:

Children who have difficulty with daily activities such as eating and dressing, or with using their body or hands.



Training Room

○ Physical Therapy

Eligible users:

Children with developmental delays or disabilities that make it difficult to walk, sit, or otherwise use their body.



Training Room

● Sibling Care

A dedicated childcare worker looks after siblings up to second grade of elementary school during therapy sessions.



● Shuttle Bus

We provide bus transportation for those who have difficulty coming to the center on their own.



Other Programs

● After-School Day Services

For elementary school students with developmental differences or disabilities, we offer water therapy twice a month with parent-child participation.



● Visit Support for Nursery Centers

For children who need specialized support in group settings, we regularly visit nursery schools and similar facilities to provide direct support for participating in group life, as well as advice for teachers.



● Home-Visit Type Child Development Support

We visit and provide therapy at the homes of children who cannot go out due to medical care needs or severe disabilities.



● Consultation Support for Children with Disabilities

We create the necessary plans for obtaining the "day-service certificate" required to use services, coordinate service use with providers, and conduct regular interviews and plan reviews.



● Usage Fees

Fees vary depending on the service; please inquire. There are also reduction programs, such as free usage for three years from April 1st following the child's third birthday.
